## Spanish Requirements (minimum 24 credits)

Courses: Students pursuing secondary-school teaching certification in Spanish must take a minimum of 24 credit hours in Spanish at the 200, 300 and 400 levels. The following courses are required: SPAN-251, 252, 317, and 328 ; SPAN 440W or 492; and at least one other 300- or 400level course. Students may also need to take SPAN-201 and 202 as prerequisites for the other courses, depending on their language skills upon arrival at Ursinus.

Study Abroad: Language majors and students preparing for certification are also required to supplement their work at Ursinus by spending a summer, a semester or an entire year in a foreign country with a program approved by the department.

Competency Exams: In addition to the course requirements, students are required to pass a qualifying examination before they will be admitted to candidacy for certification and a competency examination before being certified. These tests will examine students' linguistic competence, orally and in writing, testing phonetics, conversation, grammar and composition. The exit exam will also check their knowledge of Spanish literature and culture, including the arts, history and geography.
